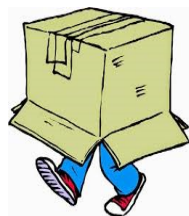

Back to School in September 2017-Fieldcrest E.S.

Classes will resume on Tuesday, September 5th, 2017. Junior Kindergarten students will begin on Thursday, September 7th, 2017. On the first day of school staff will come out to the yard with their class lists as we cannot post on the door per confidentiality legislation. Senior Kindergarten students will go to the gated kindergarten yard. Grade 1 to 3 students will go to the yard near the baseball diamond. Grade 4 to 6 students will go to the west yard (soccer field) and Gr. 7-8 students will go to the North Yard near the basketball nets/portables. If it is raining we will make an announcement with alternate arrangements. Supervision starts on the yard at 9:00 am and dismissal is at 3:35 pm.
